

Every boy Deserves Trained Leaders.

Scoutmaster and Assistant Scoutmasters are considered trained when they have completed FastStart, New Leader Essentials, Scoutmaster and Assistant Scoutmaster Leader Specific Training, and Introduction to Outdoor Leader Skills. Youth Protection is required by Troop 993. You can do it on-line

Troop Committee Members are considered trained when they have completed FastStart, New Leader Essentials and the Troop Committee Challenge as their Leader Specific Training. Youth Protection is required by Troop 993.

Qualified leaders wear the Trained Leader emblem (BSA No. 00280) on the left sleeve of their uniform shirt, immediately below and touching the emblem of office for which it was earned.

All Troop 993 Parents should have FastStart and Youth Protection Training. It is highly recommended and encouraged that All Parents also take New Leaders Essentials and Troop Committee Challenge so they can understand how the Troop operates and better support the other adult leaders. If parents are interested in camping on a regular basis with the troop and their son they should also take Introduction to Outdoor Leader Skills.

A copy of all training certificates should be given to the Troop Adult Training Coordinator who maintains these records.

Mustang District offers periodic training classes for adults and youth. For upcoming classes, check their website, www.mustangdistrict.org or attend Boy Scout Round Table, the 2nd Thursday of each month from 7:00 - 9:00 PM at the old Westchester High School at 901 Yorkchester Dr., Houston, TX 77079, about 1-2 blocks south of I-10 behind I-HOP on I-10 between Wilcrest & Kirkwood. Refer to the Scouter newspaper for special Sam Houston Area Council training opportunities.

Troop 993 has a number of video tapes that may be checked out for 1 week at a time. These include tapes for both youth and adults. Some of the tapes are the same ones you'd see at an official BSA training class. Please note: you are welcome to view them for your general information or as a refresher. But if you want to get BSA credit for the class, you need to sign up and take an official training class so that the trainer can provide that information to the BSA office!
